Minutes of meeting

Held at 7.45pm on Tuesday 27th July 2010 at Over Peover Methodist Chapel.

Present: Chair of meeting John Bennett (JB), Peter Clarkson (PC), Barry Wienholdt (BW), Bessie Coppack (BC), Sheila Read (SR), Andy Dolan (Knutsford Police), Oliver Pearson (Football Team), The Clerk.

10.76 Apologies for absence: Gordon McGrath (GM), Jill Wille (JW), Anthony Dobell (AD) sent their apologies to the meeting.

10.77 Declarations of interest in any agenda item - None declared

10.78 Minutes of May Meeting - already circulated. JB proposed and BW seconded that the minutes were a true reflection of the meeting and they were duly signed as a correct record.

10.79 Discussion of Matters arising from last meeting

- Benches - SR reported to the meeting that the bench had been installed by Mr Paul Read. The council noted their thanks to Paul and Tracey for installing the bench.
- The Affordable Housing response has been submitted and we are awaiting notification of the date of the strategic planning meeting.

10.80 Report from the football team - Oliver Pearson addressed the meeting and spoke of the football team's success this year having only 1 defeat in 20 games. They have enjoyed using the playing field and hope to continue to do so. The football team have also offered to assist with the grant for the fencing of the playing field and undertake to keep the field clear of litter. The team captain (Oliver Pearson) and referees are clamping down on the use of foul language on the pitch and the issue of parking in front of the school will be dealt with by the placing of some cones to prevent both sides of the road being congested on match days. The cricket clubs lay by is to be utilised as much as possible. They will also ensure that the game is stopped during the act of remembrance at the cenotaph cross roads. The club are covered by public liability and personal accident policies and are affiliated to the Football Association. **10.80.01 the council resolved to renew the licensing agreement between the football club and the Parish council. The Clerk to draw up new agreement for the club secretary to sign.**

10.81 Report from the Knutsford rural community policing team. Andy Dolan offered Over Peover Beat Officer's apologies for not being able to attend the meeting as he was away on holiday.

There have been no incidents reported in the area since the theft of lead from the school house. The major change is that Knutsford Police Station is now manned 24 hours which

means 8 new officers working in the area and each officer at Knutsford I aware of the beat areas and any on going incidents. The 24 hour contact number is 0845 4586380 which is a voicemail system as officers are very often out at incidents. Messages left will be dealt with promptly.

The Knutsford Team work closely with the neighbourhood watch and rural watch and there have been increasing success in both schemes. Andy Dolan reminded the meeting for the need for vigilance in the locking and securing of machinery and outbuildings.

The Chairman thanked Andy for his attendance; Simon Warr would be emailed regarding future meeting dates and venue.
