A50 - please contribute to Cheshire East's review



Following the tragic death on the A50 in October 2011 and the two other deaths that have occurred in recent years the Parish council have been trying to get action on the safety of the A50 both for road users and for those who live and work along it in Over Peover.

Despite the parish council's best efforts and subsequent reviews of the road in Over Peover recommending a speed reduction Cheshire East has said that the only way to move forward with this is to have another review as the evidence gathered in the previous reviews is now out of date.

Therefore Cheshire East highways will be conducting a review of the A50 in the coming months and there will be an opportunity for local residents and users of the road to comment and put their views forward. The Parish Council would encourage as many people as possible to do so as they do not want to see this road claim any more lives.

Olympic Torch Banner Competition



The Knutsford Local Area Partnership invite all members of their local community to **enter a 'competition' to create and design an image to be included on a Banner to be exhibited** when the official Olympic Torch visits Knutsford on 31st May 2012.

Local communities are being encouraged to enter and all you need to do is be creative and design an image or picture which represents your local Community and link it to an Olympic theme. For Example: you may choose to draw or paint a well known local landmark displayed in the 5 Olympic Rings, an athlete running **past your school or the name of a Community Group written on gold, silver and bronze medals...**

Criteria and specifications for entry are listed below:-

The competition is open to all members of the local community for example; schools, brownies, scouts, a group of friends, voluntary groups or individual residents.

All entries must be submitted to the Competition coordinator within your Town or Parish Council.

All entries must be the size of A4 and in landscape

Images can include drawings using felt tip, pen, paint, photographs, electronic images or collage

The material used can be paper or fabric

The closing date of the competition for all entries to have been submitted to the 'Embrace The Games Group' is Friday 30th March 2012

(A panel of local representatives will be selected to judge the entries)- **the 'Banner' will have capacity** for up to 100 designs and should the number of entries exceed 100, arrangements for those designs not chosen for the banner to also be displayed at the event.

The winner/s of the competition will invited to attend the 'Official torch Event' and parade the 'Banner' on the day (to be confirmed).

High Speed Broadband - Please spare 5 minutes to help !

The government is committed to installing high speed broadband across the UK by 2015. However this high speed broadband (25MB/s) is only available in areas where the providers have determined it is cost effective for them to install high speed connections and there are currently no plans for any of the mainstream providers to extend these schemes to Over Peover.

There is government funding available to help communities bridge the gaps left by the mainstream providers but these communities need to prove that there is a desire for the scheme. Therefore you can help to prove the need in Over Peover by going to www.connectingcheshire.org.uk, click on Join the campaign, and then Register your demand for high speed broadband.

Don't put it off, Do it Now it will take minutes but in the long run benefit the parish. Thank you.
