15.32 To approve the Minutes of the last Meeting on 24th February 2015. -the minutes were agreed and signed as a correct record.

15.34 Planning -

15/1287M -18 Mainwaring Road - Support the application

15/1274M - Cinder Farm - Object to the argument over permitted development and the application should not be treated as a new build. Any future development rights should be removed.

15/0614M - Barn at Roadside Farm - The Parish Council has a historical concern with this site and is awaiting an update on enforcement for existing development. They would argue the site has sufficient storage in the garage already on site.

15/1017M - Boundary Cottage - No comment

Planning decisions were brought to the attention of the meeting.

15.34.01Patton Close - The S 106 agreement was drawn up to benefit the village and planning was given on greenbelt land because local need was proven.

The Cascade was drawn up so that Over Peover residents should always have a priority for the housing. However this is being overridden by the housing authority's full occupancy rule. This

being that the house has to be given to someone who can occupy all the rooms, therefore making single people ineligible for the housing. Cllr Walton has done a great deal of work trying to resolve this issue, however has been unsuccessful.

TC feels that the Parish Council should write to Cheshire East and Plus Dane to point out that the very people who are now deemed ineligible were those who were used to prove need for housing. Lessons need to be learned and the parish council should challenge this policy. Also the terms of the S106 have not been met in that there has been very little communication with the Parish Council regarding the allocation of the houses. The concern regarding the ongoing issues of the planning application which have yet to be resolved should also be mentioned. The Meeting resolved that a letter should go to the CE of Plus Dane and CE of Cheshire East.

15.35 Finance - The receipts and payments summary was presented to the meeting. The invoices due for payment were agreed and the bank reconciliation accepted.

The Accounts for the education Foundation were accepted by the meeting, as were the Village Hall accounts.
